### Message from the Secretary – John Pearson



Well what can one say - an extremely busy term with some highs and some lows.

The highs have related to the Vic Young (South Shields) Ltd

Young Match Officials where we have ended the year with 208 new officials which exceeded our Sport England target by 80. Of especial commendation was the fact that we almost attained our aspirational target of 44 girls. 39 YMOs have undertaken officiating duties to date and 8 are now members of the Durham Referees Society. All first round games barring two have been refereed by Young Match Officials

To continue with the highs - games were undertaken in the Tees valley district under the leadership of Kev Rudd with 56 games being undertaken and 260 pupils involved. In the north the South of the Tyne district saw Bill Burdon-Taylor inaugurate the competitions at U.12 level with 6 teams entered at Ryton RFC. Sadly the U.13 competition had to be postponed.

The lows did not start out that way. A pleasing 31 schools entered the Vic Young (South Shields) Ltd Schools Union Cups. From then on in things have gone on the decline with 23 girls teams out of 32 entries (U.13/U.15) – 76% not attending. Similarly 44 out of 109 boys teams did not attend the first round and one final (U.13 – U.16) of the competitions – 44%. Sadly this has not done much for our reputation as it has left organisers, Advisers and Young Match without match time and more especially as a number of schools did not have the common decency to inform the organisers that they would not be attending. Careful consideration is being given as to how this can be handled in the future.

#### **ERFSU Representative**

The Schools Union representative to the ERFSU has to be elected annually and the ERFSU informed of the outcome.



The present incumbent is Martin Pepper, the Second Master at Barnard Castle School, who is being nominated by the Schools Union Committee to continue in this role.

Should you wish to stand for this position and teach at an affiliated school/academy/college can you please find a nominator and seconder from two other affiliated schools and let me have the nomination by Friday January 24th.

 That a tour approval is required for visiting teams as well as when going on tour to another Union, this is a World Rugby and RFU Regulation:

The FFR are now requiring a minimum of 6 weeks to sanction a visiting tour

 Regulation 15.11.3, that matches must be brought to an end if the points difference is more than 50 points, and that it is better to modify the game to allow play continue to the final whistle:
